



FSG Solar

Led by VP Michael Mastriano, FSG Solar (Division 37) is dedicated to delivering turnkey solar solutions with precision and expertise. From planning to installation, the team ensures every project meets the highest standards of quality and efficiency. With a focus on collaboration, innovation, and delivering exceptional customer experiences, FSG Solar is driving renewable energy solutions forward.

With headquarters in FL, FSG Solar has employees located in 6 states, reflecting the national reach of its projects. In 2024, the team completed projects in 11 states and Puerto Rico. Their team includes 11 core members with additional field support from other divisions. Key contributors include:

- **Solutions Team:** This four-member team led by Michael Cataline supports FSG internal sellers throughout the solar sales process.
- **Project Management Team:** This six-member team ensures successful project execution, with plans to expand as the division grows.

Field installations are supported by teams from Divisions 11, 15, and 19, enabling scalable project delivery, no matter the location.

What Does FSG Solar Do?

FSG Solar provides end-to-end solar energy solutions, supporting projects from initial evaluation to construction and energization. Key steps in the process include:

- **Opportunity Evaluation and Proposal Development:** Using tools like PV Bid and Helioscope, the Solutions Team identifies opportunities and crafts tailored proposals.
- **Design and Engineering (D&E):** After project approval, the team conducts a thorough D&E phase to ensure system compatibility.
- **Construction and Energization:** Once agreements are finalized, the Project Management Team oversees construction through to energization with the utility provider.

This comprehensive approach ensures seamless execution from start to finish.

Recent Project Highlights

- **Greenwood Corporate Plaza:** Four buildings with a combined 1 MW capacity. Despite challenges from prior customer experiences and a complex installation, FSG Solar collaborated with Division 15 to deliver the project on schedule.
- Canadian Pacific Railroad, Kansas City: Featured roof and ground-mounted installations totaling 374 kW. The project was signed in June and completed the same year thanks to Division 11's outstanding field team.
- **Upcoming Projects:** FSG Solar is set to complete seven additional projects by mid-February 2025, collectively generating 2.7 GWh of electricity with a capacity of 2 MW.

Although new to FSG, the Solar team brings the institution decades of solar installation experience across projects of all sizes and complexities. By leveraging interdepartmental collaboration and FSG's extensive network, FSG Solar is quickly scalable and poised to meet growing demands while delivering exceptional results.



As we step into 2025, the electrical, lighting, and construction industries continue to evolve amidst a dynamic economic landscape. Here's what you need to know moving forward.

Supply Chain Updates and Challenges

The new year presents ongoing challenges shaped by fluctuating commodity prices and supply chain adjustments. Copper prices, while holding steady at around \$4.50 per pound through the end of 2024, are expected to trend upwards due to continued demand and supply constraints. Global economic pressures, labor shortages, and logistical inefficiencies remain key factors influencing raw material availability.

Key commodity price projections for Q1 2025 include:

- **Copper:** Expected to remain in the \$4.50 \$4.80 per pound range.
- Aluminum: Projected at \$1.20 \$1.30 per pound.
- **Steel**: A surplus in the global market has provided some price relief, but fluctuations in demand may lead to manufacturer readjustments.
- PVC Resin: Stable prices to begin the year, but inflation pressures may cause minor shifts.

While these projections offer some predictability, the broader market's volatility highlights the importance of agile procurement strategies.

Regulatory Update: Fluorescent Lamp Bans in 2025

Starting this year, several states, including California, Colorado, Hawaii, Minnesota, Oregon, Rhode Island, and Vermont, are phasing out compact fluorescents (CFLs) and linear fluorescent lamps (T12, T8, and T5) as part of their sustainability initiatives.

What FSG Has Done to Prepare

- **ICSEC Integration:** Substitution recommendations are preloaded into ICSEC for streamlined sourcing.

FSG PREFAB UPDATES

Highlighted Project:

Med Center Arlington Tower Expansion

Contract: \$16.3 Million
Duration: 24 Months
Senior PM: Steve Burgess
Superintendent: Andy Kiefer



We have another fine example of FSG teamwork to share from Med Center Arlington! Our construction team, led by Steve Burgess and Andy Kiefer, combined with BIM support from Clint Sutherland and the production crew at FSG Prefab, all joined forces to tackle overhead racking for the job.

Utilizing spool drawings provided by Clint and his BIM Team, the Prefab shop was able to accurately and efficiently construct the overhead racking with all conduit bends and j-boxes off-site and ahead of schedule. These racks are designed for both feeder and branch circuits. Andy and his on-site team are much further ahead than they would have been using traditional stick-build methods. He said they are completing an area in 1–2 days instead of 5. All in all, Andy reports that installation has been very smooth, and Prefab has been able to keep pace with the schedule. Andy concluded that he has been very pleased overall and, if given the choice, he would never go back to stick-building racks.

As FSG moves forward into 2025, it is critical that we share these best practices with all of our construction teams company-wide. Prefab now has some demo models built in our shop, and we can utilize these models to train your field leaders and installers on the best practices for installing these rack systems. Continued Efforts in 5S: The 5S Gang Box

One of our biggest risks in construction is the waste of valuable productive labor. We invest in our electricians to make them best in class: we train them, and we provide them with the tools and information they need to be successful every day. Their productivity directly correlates to the profitability of our projects. How many actual "productive" hours are you able to get out of your crew each day? How much of their time is lost to non-productive tasks—waiting for information, looking for materials, or searching for tools?

At FSG's Prefab Shop, we are laser-focused on eliminating waste in our daily operations. One way we leverage the tools of LEAN manufacturing is by implementing 5S principles in the organization of tools, materials, and clean-up processes. For example, we applied these principles to our gang box of tools to reduce the time crews spend searching for items like grinders, torque wrenches, or any other tools they need to complete their tasks.

The interior of the cabinet has been painted white to improve lighting and visibility. We also added lighting with an occupancy sensor for automatic control—open the doors, and voilà! Power is available inside for battery charging. Finally, the tools are sorted, and the shelves are labeled. The result is a gang box where tools are immediately visible and accessible, reducing wasted time and increasing productivity. 

The Challenge: Bowen Technovation needed a lighting upgrade to enhance workspace functionality while reducing energy consumption.

The Solution: Our team provided a tailored package, including high-bay fixtures and sensor-controlled linear strips, strategically placed to optimize efficiency across their facility.

The Result: Bowen Technovation now enjoys an annual energy use reduction of 14,878 kWh, resulting in significant utility savings!






