

ENTERPRISE UPDATES

LIGHTING BUSINESS

FSG is in the process of transitioning our lighting business from separate operating companies to a *unified enterprise model*, and we've got some exciting updates.

Our goal is a unified lighting business nationwide that better serves both our branches and our customers. We're already seeing positive results as branches come on board, and our teams are growing with both market-based and Dallas-based employees.

Our Customer Service Representatives (CSR) team is already taking calls in the Dallas National Service Center. As our first line of customer contact, they're already showing good results. Early KPIs show improved service thanks to greater scalability and capacity.

We've nearly completed onboarding the Western Region lighting businesses: California, Denver, Phoenix, Albuquerque, and El Paso. Next is the Central Region, home to all Texas-based lighting operations, which represent our largest MRO activity by both transactions and customer volume.

Branch transitions include:

- Moving market-based employees to one of two national lighting teams:
 Lighting Quotations & Design and National Lighting Operation.
- Transitioning phones and group emails to the CSR Group.
- Training local operations on the new Lighting Enterprise processes.

Operating as one enterprise will provide consistent, professional quotations and submittals, upgraded service levels, and an improved customer experience. By leveraging national pricing and partnering with preferred vendors offering rebates and incentives, we're already beginning to see improved margins. We remain committed to regular reporting to demonstrate the success of the enterprise rollout as we move forward.

We've seen outstanding collaboration among regional team members, which was the central goal of this rollout. With more than 200 employees and thousands of customers involved, early results are already pointing to a better experience for both our employees and our customer partners. As the rollout continues, we'll provide regular updates to ensure a smooth transition for both our operations and our customers.

This transition is about more than process changes. It's about ALL of us working as one team to create a better experience for our customers and a stronger future for FSG.

PROJECT HIGHLIGHTS

TEXAS A&M SPACE INSTITUTE - FSG Houston

FSG Houston is currently working on the construction of the new Texas A&M University Space Institute, a state-of-the-art facility located on a 32-acre site leased from NASA along Saturn Lane, adjacent to Rocket Park and the entrance of the Johnson Space Center in Houston.

The 370,000 SF facility will bring together academic, commercial, and government entities with dedicated areas designed to advance space research and workforce development.

Key features include:

- Conditioned Moon and Mars "scapes" for full-scale engineering, science, health and medicine simulations, mission development, and training.
- Enclosed, secured research garages to support academic, industry, and government R&D.
- Common technical support areas for specialty equipment and shared research activities.
- Flexible project rooms for engineering and science teams, control room functions, and collaboration.
- Visitor lobby, lecture hall, and office areas to welcome guests and support day-to-day operations.

Slated for completion in 2026, the Space Institute will position Texas A&M as a national leader in space engineering and help maintain Texas' role at the forefront of space exploration.

FSG Houston is honored to contribute to this landmark project that will shape the future of technology, workforce training, and discovery both on Earth and beyond. Be on the lookout for more updates as the project progresses.









PROJECT HIGHLIGHTS

NEW PEDIATRIC CAMPUS - FSG Dallas

FSG Dallas is leading construction on the largest healthcare project in the institution's history. This 2,000,000 sq ft medical campus is a partnership between Children's and UTSW and will feature 6,000 parking spaces, 552 beds, 96 beds in a Level IV NICU, 27 imaging modalities, and 20 operating rooms. The facility will also include the region's only Level I Pediatric Trauma Center, setting a new standard for children's care.

More than a building, this effort represents a rare opportunity to reshape pediatric healthcare on a scale not seen in decades. The foundation for this success comes from the excellence shown at the recently completed Children's Hospital in Plano, where the team proved what is possible through dedication and collaboration.

Highlights of the project include:

- 552 patient beds, with 96 in a specialized Level IV NICU.
- 27 imaging suites designed for advanced diagnostic care.
- 20 modern operating rooms to support complex procedures.
- A first-of-its-kind Level I Pediatric Trauma Center for the region.
- Parking for 6,000 vehicles to serve patients, families, and staff.

With work projected to continue through 2030, this project will deliver years of steady opportunity for the Dallas team while advancing the future of pediatric medicine.

FSG Dallas is proud to play a pivotal role in a project that will strengthen healthcare for generations of families across the region. Stay tuned for progress updates as the work moves forward.











SUPPLY CHAIN & TARIFF WATCH

As we close out 2025, sourcing teams across FSG continue to navigate tariffs, commodity volatility, and shifting supplier strategies. Staying vigilant and proactive remains essential as we head into 2026.

LEGISLATION & POLICY UPDATES

- EV Infrastructure Funding (NEVI program) continues into FY2026 validate state-level approvals before committing site schedules.
- "One Big Beautiful Bill" continues to drive construction spend with labor and supply constraints, adding cost pressures.
- **Copper:** Holding near \$4.55/lb volatility expected due to tight concentrates and demand.
- **Wire & Cable:** Pricing tied directly to copper swings enforce escalator clauses where applicable.
- **Diesel & Freight:** Moderated from mid-year highs, but carriers continue to implement *fuel surcharges*.
- **Lighting Controls & Components:** Products with Chinese content remain exposed to Section 301 duties confirm COO and alternatives in advance.

SECTION 301 TARIFFS

- USTR extended select China tariff exclusions through November 29, 2025.
- Solar AD/CVD rulings introduce **retroactive duty risk** for modules sourced from Southeast Asia.
- **Solar Modules:** Sourcing remains complex anticipate reshoring trends, but short-term risk of retroactive duties persists.

PROJECT HIGHLIGHT: 111MW Data Center

When our construction and BIM team in Dallas reviewed the drawings for this data center project, they quickly identified the conduit racking system on the roof as an ideal opportunity to implement prefabrication.

Traditionally, this scope of work would require all materials to be received, stored, transported, and then cut, bent, and assembled directly on the roof. Add the unpredictability of this summer's weather, and the risks multiply. On fast-paced, mission-critical projects like this one, finding creative ways to reduce risk while maintaining schedule pressure is essential.

That's where FSG Prefabrication's shop in San Antonio stepped in. The team handled cutting, bending, and assembling each section of the system before carefully packaging and shipping them to the job site. Once on site, the assemblies were staged for consolidated crane lifts to the roof, streamlining the installation process and minimizing downtime.

One unique decision made early in the process was to send a couple of electricians from the prefab shop to the job site for the first few days of installation. Their hands-on experience with these complex assemblies proved invaluable, providing the field crew with immediate support and insight. Too often, the knowledge gained during prefabrication isn't fully transferred to the installation team; this collaboration helped close that gap.

The reverse also holds true - sending job site leaders to the prefab shop during assembly can give them a head start on understanding installation challenges. This two-way handoff of best practices, knowledge, and first-hand experience creates smoother transitions, reduces mistakes, and adds measurable value to the project.

This approach is one more example of how FSG leverages continuous improvement and prefabrication to drive efficiency, reduce risk, and deliver mission-critical projects successfully.

I was able to work with Pam to design some specific tool holders for our workstations and then make them on our 3D printer.

FSG PREFAB

PREFAB'S LEAN JOURNEY

Continuous Improvement is the systematic process of making small, incremental changes that eliminate waste and deliver more value to our customers.

At FSG Prefab, we thrive on new challenges, and this project gave us a big one: a chance to prove we could take on something complex for our Mission Critical team in Dallas and deliver real results.

The project centered around building massive rooftop conduit racks. Each assembly held up to thirty 3" EMT and fifty 1" EMT conduits, supported by a framework of Unistrut and rooftop support blocks. Every 10-foot section had to be dry-fit with the ones before and after it to guarantee a perfect match.

Early on, we identified alignment as a challenge. Traditional tape measure checks were too slow and prone to error, so we introduced additional line lasers to help square each assembly. The impact was immediate: faster setups, higher accuracy, and a noticeable improvement in overall quality. Yes, Pythagoras still has his place, but lasers win every time.

Weight was another hurdle. With so many conduits and heavy supports, precise adjustments would be nearly impossible by using only forklifts. Our solution? Portable gantry cranes with chain falls. These gave us the fine control needed for complex fits while also improving safety and making maneuvering completed sections off the line easier.

These two major adjustments, paired with countless smaller process tweaks, delivered real efficiency gains. More importantly, they showcased how a culture of continuous improvement empowers our teams to solve problems creatively, work more safely, and deliver smarter.

Biblical Perspectives for Wise Living by Deon Snider

BIBLICAL PERSPECTIVE: STEWARDSHIP OF THE GIFT OF LIFE

Life is precious and brief. Every day, we're reminded of this truth through tragedies in the world around us and through the passing of those we know and love. Some are taken in the prime of life, others after many decades of faithful service, but each loss reminds us that our lives are a gift from God, entrusted to us for His purposes.

The Bible uses the picture of a steward, or someone entrusted to manage what belongs to another. Paul wrote, "Moreover, it is required in stewards that one be found faithful" (1 Cor. 4:2). Our lives, our time, and our talents belong to the Lord. The question is not whether we will leave a mark, but what kind of mark we will leave.

WHAT FAITHFUL STEWARDSHIP LOOKS LIKE

- Rooted in Christ True stewardship begins with knowing Christ personally. "If you confess with your mouth Jesus as Lord, and believe in your heart that God raised Him from the dead, you will be saved" (Rom. 10:9–10). Life begins with this confession of faith and continues as we walk in His grace.
- Obedience and Daily Surrender Jesus called His followers to "deny themselves, take up their cross daily, and follow Me" (Lk. 9:23). Stewardship is not occasional it's the daily pattern of living for Christ instead of ourselves.
- Compassionate Relationships Our stewardship is seen in how we treat others. Paul urged believers to clothe themselves with compassion, kindness, humility, gentleness, and patience (Col. 3:12-14). Faithful stewards serve others, forgive freely, and let love be the bond of unity.
- Truth Spoken in Love Stewardship includes our words. "Speaking the truth in love" (Eph. 4:15) means we balance honesty with grace. Our words should be used to build others up, not to flatter or tear down, always seeking their good.
- Pursuing Godly Priorities Faithful stewards aren't driven by money, status, or approval. Instead, we're called to "pursue righteousness, godliness, faith, love, perseverance, and gentleness" (1 Tim. 6:11). What we chase reveals what we treasure.

THE CALL OF STEWARDSHIP

Stewardship isn't passive! It's active servant leadership. It means leading by serving, using influence to bless others, and pointing people to Christ through both word and deed. It means standing firm in faith, even when unpopular, and using every opportunity to do good. The apostle Paul wrote, "Be on the alert, stand firm in the faith, act like men, be strong" (1 Cor. 16:13). To be a faithful steward is to live with courage and conviction, trusting God with the results.

In the end, stewardship isn't measured by what we keep but by what we give: our time, our service, our compassion, and our witness. May we each be found faithful with the one life we've been given, living in such a way that others see Christ in us and are drawn closer to Him.

The implementation of mobile gantry cranes has been instrumental in making precise adjustments during the alignment and dry fitting of racks, as well as in their movement off the line. Additionally, the utilization of multiple lasers has been key in ensuring squareness and enhancing our quality control processes. To streamline the layout process and minimize human error, our team has constructed jigs that reduce reliance on traditional tape measures. We also added soft shackles to our rigging setup to reduce wasted extra processing of mechanical shackles. This build is just getting started, and we are racking up the continuous improvement moments!


