• Prepare sketches showing the location of wiring and equipment, or follow diagrams or blueprints, ensuring that concealed wiring is installed before completion of future walls, ceilings, and flooring.

Plan new or modified installations to minimize waste of materials, provide access for future maintenance, and avoid unsightly, hazardous, and unreliable wiring, consistent with specifications, safety codes, and local electrical codes.

Plan layout and installation of electrical wiring, equipment, or fixtures, based on job specifications and local codes.

Install control and distribution apparatus such as switches, relays, and circuit-breaker panels; install Buss, electrical feeders, power systems and/or switchgear.

Repair faulty equipment or systems.

Advise management on whether continued operation of equipment could be hazardous.

Meet attendance standards and comply with late/absence notification procedures.

Maintain current electrician's license or identification card to meet governmental regulations. Able to work a flexible schedule that may include overtime, evenings, and weekends.

Must be able to lift large pieces of equipment as needed.
