## Responsibilities

· Counseling employees and managers on policy issues

Assist jobsite safety audits and follow-up as needed.

Ensure Job Hazard Analysis is conducted in accordance with company policy.

Ensure Energized Permits are conducted in accordance with company policy

Investigate and conduct Root Cause Analysis for incidents and accidents.

Assist the Safety and Risk Manager with the investigations of all major incidents/accidents (e.g. shocks, serious falls/back injuries)

Assist the branch in conducting the vehicle checklist. Follow-up on the inspections that were done.

Jobsite Paperwork- make sure each new jobsite has all appropriate signage
